

- Facilitating transport operations and promoting international trade










Missions of CESNI

- Adopt technical standards in various fields [...] to which the respective regulations at the European and international level, including those of the EU and the CCNR, may refer with a view to their application
- Deliberate on the uniform interpretation and application of the said standards [...]
- Deliberate on derogations and equivalences of technical requirements for a specific craft
- Deliberate on priority topics regarding safety of navigation, protection of the environment, and other areas of inland navigation.



Achievements of CESNI


 Standards permanently developed and improved in close cooperation with shipping industry, social actors and other stakeholders

ES-TRIN 2017, adopted in July 2017 **ES-TRIN 2019**, to be adopted in November 2018 (pending) **Standards in the field of professional qualifications**, to be adopted in November 2018 (pending)

- Better governance: opportunities for partners to join forces and reduction of duplications in the works
- Convergence of regulatory frameworks

- Ensure level playing field
