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

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


The European standard for qualifications in inland navigation (ES-QIN): A European frame of reference for qualified personnel

- Since 2015: CESNI Committee is working on standards related to professional qualification in inland navigation
- Standards in ES-QIN lay down details of a new competence-based approach for qualifications of deck crew members
- New regulatory framework: System of harmonised professional qualifications within the EU and on the Rhine
- From January 2022: no recognition procedures or validation of experience, if applicants for certificates of qualification met the requirements for competence and practical examination as well as the medical criteria listed in ES-QIN



Implementation of the ES-QIN 2019



CESNI standards are not binding per se.

The EU, the CCNR and other international organisations or third countries will be able to apply the standards by integrating them into their respective legal frameworks.

Main objectives of ES-QIN

- Provide up to date and high quality standards for professional qualifications in inland navigation in Europe
- Serve as a reference for legislators inside and outside EU and CCNR
- Foster labour mobility
- Make the profession more attractive
- Ensure safe navigation by means of ambitious requirements in terms of knowledge, skills, exams and examination tools as well as fitness and
- Enable companies and crews to adapt to technical and logistic innovation



Content ES-QIN edition 2019

• Part I: Standards for competences

→ Operational and management level, sailing on inland waterways with a maritime character, with the aid of radar, passenger navigation expert, LNG expert

• Part II: Standards for practical examinations

- → Sailing with the aid of radar, passenger navigation expert, LNG expert, boatmaster, additional module on supervision (boatmaster)
- Part III: Standards for approval of simulators
- Part IV: Standards for medical fitness (general fitness, vision and hearing)
- Part V: Standards for models of crew related documents
 - \rightarrow e.g. certificate of qualification, service record book, logbook

QP-3	Draft standards for basic safety training for deckhands
QP-4	Draft standards for standardised communication phrases in four languages
QP-5	Draft standards for environment-friendly and efficient vessel operation (eco navigation)
QP-6	Draft standards for the use of digital equipment for examination other than for the practical examination for obtaining the qualification as a boatmaster and for the specific authorisation to sail with the aid of radar
QP-7	Draft "standards" for the administration of certificates (issuing, suspension, withdrawal etc.)

QP-17	Deliberation on the uniform interpretation and application of the standards with a view to draft FAQ or service instructions to competent authorities if need be
QP-18	Draft standards for the implementation of theoretical exams for competence standards
QP-19	Guidelines for monitoring of training, assessment and certification (quality assurance system) including in third countries
QP-20	Preparation and organisation of the joint meeting of the examination bodies
QP-21	Analysis and technical advice on possible ways forward at European level based on TASCS project results

Maintenance of guidance documents and standards outside ES-QIN e.g. practical examination on OL, basic safety training for deckhands, standard phrases, medical certificates, good practice in administration of certificates etc.
