### ES-QIN, Part I, Chapter 1: Standards of competence for the operational level (Resolution CESNI 2018-II-3)

- 1. Navigation
- 2. Operation of the craft
- 3. Cargo handling, stowage and passenger transport
- 4. Marine engineering and electrical, electronic and control engineering
- 5. Maintenance and repair
- 6. Communication
- 7. Health and safety and environmental protection



#### **Example from the standards of competence**

1.1. The boatman shall be able to assist the management of the craft in situations of manoeuvring and handling a craft on inland waterways. The boatman shall be able to do so, on all types of waterways and all types of ports.

In particular, the boatman shall be able to:

1. assist with mooring, unmooring and hauling (towage) <u>operations;</u>	Knowledge of equipment, material and procedures used on board for mooring, unmooring and hauling (towage) operations. ## Draft standards for the practical examination for obtaining a certificate of qualification on OL (2)

Document CESNI/QP/QM (20) 49 rev. 2

#### **Category I:**

Examiners shall test all category I elements.

Applicants must reach a minimum of 7 out of 10 points in each element.

#### **Category II:**

Examiners shall test <u>20 category II elements</u>. Examiners are free to decide on the content of the elements they select.

Applicants must reach a minimum total score of 120 points.



## Draft standards for the practical examination for obtaining a certificate of qualification on OL (3)

Document CESNI/QP/QM (20) 49 rev. 2

2. Technical requirements for craft and simulators used for the practical examination

Examination can be carried out in an appropriate onshore installation or on a craft covered by Article 2 of Directive (EU) 2017/2397. The examination of the elements 1 – 11 can be carried out on the craft or on an approved vessel handling simulator that complies with ES-QIN.
