Content of ES-QIN





Requirements of ES-QIN

- work with up-to-date charts and maps, notices to skippers and mariners and other publications specific to waterways with a maritime character
- use tidal datums, tidal currents, periods and cycles, the time of tidal currents and tides and variations across an estuary
- use SIGNI and IALA for safe navigation on inland waterways with a maritime character


Procedure of the exam


- Only oral exam
- No written or practical part
- Duration: ~ 30 45 min.
- One applicant
- Exam commission: 1 Chair (member of the exam authority) and 2 examiners (must be holder of the specific authorisation « Inland waterways with maritime character »)




Content of exam

- 1. Part « Sea map »
- Questions concerning using the map: Meaning of the signs on the map, how to navigate using beacons...
- Candidate has to calculate and set a course on the map, has to read of a position
- 2. « Question-Part »
- Aspects and influence of tides
- Questions concerning nautical traffic regulations that differ from the traffic regulations in inland navigation
- Use of Powerpoint-slides













Assessment of the exam

Examination is passed if...

- 70 % of questions are answered correctly and
- no mistake that indicate that candidate lacks indispensable knowledge

When is this the case?

- 70 % of questions correct → « The performance fully meets the requirements »
- In Germany: Scope for the assessment of the exam commission
